

CIRCULAR

I am directed to state that process of procurement through an 'unsolicited proposal' under rule 60 of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014 may only be initiated if the procurement is of works and the following mandatory pre-requisites are fulfilled:

- (a) the procurement is for an engineering, procurement and consultancy (EPC) works project; and
- (b) total cost of the project is one thousand million rupees or it is more than this minimum amount; and
- (c) the procuring agency, for reasons to be recorded in writing, finds the unsolicited proposal viable.

2. If the above mandatory pre-requisites are fulfilled, a procuring agency may initiate the process of procurement of works through unsolicited proposal by advertising the proposal for open competition under rule 60 of the Punjab Procurement Rules 2014.
