
2. One of the core function of Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) is to provide support, training and capacity building / professional development policy of officers/officials and other persons engaged in public procurement. PPRA has been launching training program for the relevant personnel of the Procuring Agencies since its establishment. In order to build the capacity of senior & mid-level officials along with the enlisted suppliers in each department, nominations of relevant persons belong to/attached with your organization engaged in procurement assignments are required to enrolled in Capacity Building Programs going to be organized by PPRA.

Kindly select one of venues i.e. your committee room / offices or PPRA office, if the procuring agency opt the option of its own venue for training to its officer / officials then communicate venue / date & time as per your convenience. PPRA shall arrange a team of

experts along with relevant training material for conducting the training. In this case the department would require to pay the resource person fee at the government approved rates. Management Professional Development Department (MPDD) fee rate can vicariously be implied. In case training is decided to be held in PPRA office then the nominating agency shall be required to pay Rs.1500/- per nominee per day to PPRA in advance through a deposit slip/draft/pay order in PPRA bank A/c No.6010046949500024 (MD PPRA) being maintained in Bank of Punjab (BOP) Punjab civil Secretariat branch Lahore and copy of receipt shall be submitted to PPRA alongwith nomination. These training session will be duly certified by PPRA.

4. Moreover, it is intimated that the government in order to make the procurement processes more immaculate is going to limit the procurement process be conducted only by those officers/officials who are duly certified by PPRA. It is further informed that this certification is mandatory for all Project Directors, Allied Staff involved in procurement and also for Auditor General Punjab Auditors to enhance their capacity on public procurement including donor procurement guidelines as per instruction issued by Planning Commission Ministry of Planning Development & Special Initiatives Government of Pakistan.
