SUBJECT: INSTRUCTIONAL CONFERENCE ON PUNJABs' INDIGENIZED & AUTONOMOUS E-PROCUREMENT SYSTEM AND INTEGRATION OF FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS WITH BANK OF PUNJAB

E-procurement is vital to strengthening Public Procurement management system in the province with the objective to bolster value for money and constructive competition. Moreover, it is quintessential to the concept of creating ease in doing business. Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) is regulating procurement activities through e-PADS Version 1.0, which is a federally administered digital platform. Federal PPRA retains full ownership and control of the system, while PPRA has no assured role in key decisions.

2. Therefore, PPRA, in close collaboration with the Punjab Information Technology Board (PITB), has developed an indigenous, autonomous and province-specific Punjab e-Procurement System (EP). The said system has been designed keeping in view the procurement requirements, administrative structure and operational needs of Punjab. The system offers enhanced interoperability and data triangulation capabilities, along with digitalization of Bid Security and Performance Guarantees with Bank of Punjab (BOP) to improve efficiency and reduce manual intervention.

3. In the recently convened 54th meeting of Board of Management, (BOM) it was desired by the Worthy Chief Secretary, Punjab that a seminar/instructional conference on procurement legal framework and e-procurement (challenges & way forward) may be organized for all secretaries, head of attached departments and autonomous bodies. In consonance with these directions of Honorable Chairman PPRA, an event is going to be organized, focusing on **public procurement and the regulatory framework and Punjab's indigenized & autonomous e-procurement system**, to be held on 18th June, 2026 at Flatties Hotel, Lahore from 11:00 am to 01:00 pm.
